- Presenters: Julie Stewart, Associate Professor & Director FNP Program and Vickie Osborne, BSW Program Director & Clinical Assistant Professor

Julie noted that her FNP students received the training and simulation well. Students appreciated something outside of Blackboard at the end of the semester. Vickie reported on experience with social work students. She implemented with junior and senior BSW students and could not make it a required assignment. Thus, saw low completion rates. She also posted slides to Blackboard, but even though she paired them down, student feedback indicated too many slides. Vickie will implement with the MSW students and new BSW juniors in the fall 2017 term. She will provide more encouragement and strong suggestions will be given to the faculty as well as students. Simulation will also be included as an assignment in the syllabus (either extra credit or an actual assignment grade).

LC members discussed strategies around making the simulation required or optional. Most members make it required. Charles Syms noted that he requires it and broke the slides down into sections.

Terry Chase asked: did you notice any difference in the motivation, interest between nursing and social work students? Vickie Osborne response: Once we get qualitative feedback we can look at that; social work students (from what I saw) were motivated particularly because many of them had completed the adult SBIRT training the semester prior

Vickie Osborne posed a question to the LC to hear about the courses where LC members implement the curriculum. The following courses were mentioned:

- Foundation classes and we implement the entire model with Kognito in our Advanced Direct practice classes
