3. Learn and Share Presentation – Tracy

- Stella Resko, Assistant Professor, Coordinator of Certificate in Alcohol and Drug Abuse Studies, Wayne State University

NOTES:

Stella presented on her implementation experiences at an urban university. Wayne State is implementing the training in Bachelor's of Social Work and Master's of Social Work courses. The online simulation was assigned with a brief questionnaire as a homework assignment with a call to participate in a research study. In an advanced clinical practice course, the simulation was conducted as an in class activity with follow up survey and call for participation in study. 124 trainees exposed to training with 73 completing on their own and 51 completing as an in-class activity. Most participants were social work students and completed the entire training with positive feedback. Overall instructor feedback was positive. Stella conducted a mixed-methods evaluation with posttest only design. Her results were published in the Journal of Social Work Practice in the Addictions. doi: 10.1080/15332256X.2017.1304948

Discussion:

Nicole Bennett raised concern about willingness to adopt Kognito simulation when it is time-limited and Tracy McPherson shared that we are doing everything that we can to work with our funder to extend access. The Learning Collaborative feedback and learn and shares is a great way to show the demand for the material.

One area that we have heard is of interest, is on high-need, under resourced schools and/or populations. Tracy asked for opinions or experience on focusing efforts in these areas and, in particular, guidance on how we define these populations. This question is predicated on the idea that we are looking for ways to make the most impact. Suggestions were made to look at zip code data and rural areas. We could also target city colleges and state colleges, underfunded hospitals, or look at communities with federally-qualified health centers.

In Stella's study, some faculty expressed desire for greater diversity of social workers depicted in the simulation and in the adolescents. Tracy noted that expanding scenarios and expanding the program is a top priority for the future of this program, but we need to make some decisions around where and how to expand. Do we expand the scenarios, expand into co-occurring disorders, expand disciplines, types of practitioners? This is a longer discussion that we will have with the Learning Collaborative in the coming months.
