3. Learn and Share

- Introduction - Tracy
 - University of Manitoba – Social Work, Tracey Bone, PhD, MSW, Assistant Professor

NOTES:

Dr. Bone met with social work students in a computer lab and walked through the simulation as a group. The class is 3 hours long. For the first half, students receive training on SBIRT (students studied MI in a previous course). As a group the students completed one Kognito scenario. Students are required to complete the rest of the simulation program on their own.

Dr. Bone discussed difficulties with using the simulation in a group setting, preferring to have the ability to move forward and backward through the simulation. Another participant commented on group approach: “We have done a group approach where we have one Kognito simulation open and we walk through it as a group. This allows the group to think through and discuss the options and come to a "group" choice.” SBIRT Team clarified that once a student goes through the full program in a linear way, they can go in and out of program segments in any order. Also, instructors can have access to a version of the simulation that does not require them to go through the program in a linear way which facilitates demonstrating the simulation in a group setting.

Dr. Janet Noles has also integrated Kognito into her course. She teaches in an integrated program where students come to campus 1 week at a time for 3 months – doctoral students expected to assume professional roles. Students outside of the pediatrics program requested access to the

training. Dr. Noles modified the informed consent form so that the simulation could be integrated into classes.
