NORC is considering releasing a second RFA but wanted to gauge interest from Learning Collaborative members. Cathy Koetting and other call participants expressed interest in another RFA and wondered if there was a possibility of expanding the adolescent SBIRT training to the current workforce. Tracy noted that this would be something that the team would consider if there is another RFA. She also called attention to the National ATTC which has webinars for the current workforce. Other members also voiced an interest in allowing collaboration beyond nursing and social work as some institutions work with other schools such as schools of dentistry. Pat Herlihy asked if current education places a focus on empowering students to bring what they learn from classroom into the workforce. Valire Copeland clarified that in her experience though students should feel confident in their knowledge, millennials aren't as comfortable asserting themselves in the workplace right out of school so training of the current workforce is important. The American Psychiatric Nurses Association has an SBIRT position paper on topics relevant to this discussion. NORC will post this paper on its website.

Adolescent SBIRT Curriculum

NORC is finalizing the SBIRT Curriculum that will be housed at http://sbirt.webs.com/curriculum. This page will include the Instructor's Guide with slide decks, a syllabus, curriculum overview, information for the SBI with Adolescent simulation program, and other supplemental materials. Learning Collaborative members can expect to have access to the full Instructor's Toolkit with the guide by Friday, January 22nd. NORC will release a communication via email when the guide is released.

Tracy noted that the Instructor's Guide was written for a variety of populations not necessarily just for instructors. Additionally, this version is considered a beta-version because it can evolve to fit the needs of users. If members use it in their programs and realize that there are things missing or have suggestions for it to better fit into current curriculum, they are encouraged to email SBIRTTeam@norc.org. The purpose of this guide is to make integration of adolescent SBIRT as easy as possible so NORC is open to creating something that will do that even if that involved future editing of the guide.

NORC is still working out the ordering process for hardcopies of the guide. There will be an order form on the curriculum page. Details on how to order including any costs associated will all be detailed in the communication indicating release of the guide.

Adolescent SBIRT Needs Assessment

The needs assessment survey closed on December 31st, 2015. NORC received 264 total responses with 139 fully completed and 125 partially completed surveys. NORC is working with its partner to analyze the data from the surveys.

SBIRT Webinars

As alluded to on previous calls, NORC is creating SBIRT related webinars as well as working with partners on similar topics. Webinar topics that will take place this year include Motivational Interviewing, case studies of current SBIRT programming, and how to include field supervisors and preceptors. The project team may also do one on what is available including screenshots of resources and websites.
