NORC at the University of Chicago is working with the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN), the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE), the Center for Clinical Social Work (CCSW), and technology partner Kognito to develop and evaluate an adolescent screening, brief intervention, and referral to treatment (SBIRT) curriculum for nursing, social work, and inter-professional education programs. TRACK C

INSTRUCTOR'S TOOLKIT AND SIMULATION PROGRAM

Who can participate? Social Work or Nursing education programs within an academic institution (Bachelor's/Master's/Doctoral). Participation in the Track C program includes FREE access to the Adolescent SBIRT Instructor's Toolkit and SBI with Adolescents simulation program including a limited number of licenses for field instructors/preceptors and technical support from the NORC SBIRT Team and Kognito. The Kognito simulation access also includes usage reports of simulation program use. (Simulation access ends 12/31/17).

TRACK D

FIELD INSTRUCTOR & PRECEPTOR PROGRAM

Who can participate? Placement site for a Nursing or Social Work education program (Bachelor's/Master's/Doctoral). Participating Field Instructors and Preceptors will receive FREE access to an online simulation training on administering SBIRT with adolescents for substance use and alcohol use, two FREE continuing education (CE) credits, and a certificate of completion. (Simulation access ends 12/31/17).
